TOPIC	Speaking Out	
KEY TEXTS	<i>Overheard in a Tower Block by Joseph Coelho</i> <i>Booked by Alexander Kwame</i> <i>The Works chosen by Pie Corbett</i>	
ENGLISH <i>CRC Articles</i> 2, 3, 5, 12, 13, 17, 28	Performance Poetry This half term, the children will be analysing, interpreting and appraising a range of poems written by Joseph Coelho. They will then go compose their own poems using the writing style that they have identified in the poems they have appraised. Using these poems, the children will understand what makes an effective performance and how to emulate this themselves.	
MATHS <i>CRC Articles</i> 28, 29, 30	Application of Maths This half term, the children will be applying their mathematical knowledge gained over the year to a variety of open-ended investigations. Examples of these team projects are: Designing a theme-park, architecture and interior design, landscaping and tessellation.	
SCIENCE <i>CRC Articles</i> 7, 8, 28, 29	Electricity Children will be able to associate the brightness of a lamp or the volume of a buzzer with the number and voltage of cells used in a circuit. They will learn how to compare and give reasons for variations in how components function, including the brightness of bulbs, the loudness of buzzers and the on/off position of switches. Whilst learning this, they will develop the knowledge to recognise symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram.	
COMPUTING <i>CRC Articles</i> 8, 12, 14, 16, 17, 28, 29, 30, 31, 36	E-Safety The children will look into how to stay safe online focusing specifically on: settings, privacy, friends and money.	Communication The children will learn how to use Pixlr, a photo-editing programme similar to Photoshop. They will look at book covers, traditional and modern, and analyse how they entice readers. They will develop their digital art skills by using layers, filters and effects to create variety of appealing book covers.
GEOGRAPHY <i>CRC Articles</i> 10, 17, 22, 25, 27, 29, 30	I'm a Y6 student, get me out of here! Children will use field work skills to investigation human and physical geographical features within the local area. The children will use a range of maps to plan an assortment of journeys to secondary school with the human and physical features in mind.	
DT <i>CRC Articles</i> 13, 28, 29	Fairgrounds Children will enjoy practising and extending their knowledge of electrical circuitry and switches by making this a circus-type carousel. They will follow the design and technology process of finding stakeholders, making models and experimenting with different materials.	

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MUSIC <i>CRC Articles</i> 28, 29	Year 6 Performance Following the style of The Beat Goes On, the children will be composing and performing a production that draws together their time at Cleveland Road Primary School. Music History This term Year 6 will be continuing to work on the song they composed about war and they will be learning about different periods from the Music History, such as the Renaissance, Baroque, Classical Period, Romantic Period and 20th Century. They will also revise many of the things that have been learned this year.	
	Sports Day Games and Activities The children will practise a variety of team building skills, which will also build their strength and stamina for various competitive athletic activities, for example, shotput, relays and javelin.	Swimming The children will begin weekly swimming lessons, where they will be learning how to stay safe in and around the water. The children will learn different strokes and build their confidence in the water.
RE <i>CRC Articles</i> 12, 13, 14, 28, 29	What will make our city/ town/ borough a more respectful place? Students will be comparing and contrasting different religions to find out what each says about the concept respect. Through that they will see how the community they live in shows respect and what they, as members of the community, could do to increase respect around them.	
PSHE <i>CRC Articles</i> 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 10, 12, 13, 16, 17, 28, 29, 36, 37, 38	Transition: Finance and Changing Me This half term the children will preparing for their next chapter. They will be learning the value of money and how to budget and manage their own finances. Furthermore, they will understand the importance of positive self-esteem and how to develop this. We will also address any worries about transitions into secondary school and teach them to the tools on how to deal with anxieties.	
Spanish <i>CRC Articles</i> 7, 8, 29	Holiday Destinations This half term the children will think about where they would like to go on holiday and consider what would be most appropriate to wear for their chosen destination. They will be able to write phrases and sentences from memory and change them to express their ideas. They will also choose the most effective adjectives and verbs to describe an action.	
Safeguarding <i>CRC Articles</i> 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 10, 12, 13, 16, 17, 28, 29, 36, 37, 38	Over this half term the children will have many opportunities to express themselves and who they are, as we are focusing on developing their individuality. The children will read and listen to many poems that are inspired by transitional periods in life. Using this, they will be developing their assertiveness and independence skills ready for secondary school.
